IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these Chapter 11 cases shall be jointly administered under the case name of Maxxis Group, Inc., Case No. 03-77243 in accordance with Rule 1015(b) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; and



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for the Debtors shall serve a copy of this Order on the United States Trustee and the twenty largest creditors of each estate.


