### **ORDER**

### BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 3, 2003, Southern Public Communication Association filed its Complaint against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. contending that BellSouth owes refunds for the period before it made a tariff filing reducing rates.

On February 4, 2004, BellSouth filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss the Complaint. It contends the Commission lacks the ability to grant the relief requested by the Complainant; that relief is prohibited by the filed rate doctrine; and BellSouth has not waived its right to rely upon the tariff filing requirements.

On March 15, 2004, Southern Public Communication Association filed its Response in Opposition to the Motion to Dismiss. It contends a refund is mandated by

federal law. Also, the Commission has discretion to exercise its equitable rate making power to force BellSouth to comply with §276 through the issuance of refunds.

It appears, and we find, that the reasoning of BellSouth's Motion to Dismiss is very compelling and the Motion is due to be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the Complaint filed by Southern Public Communication Association against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. is hereby dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this Order shall be effective as of the date hereof.
