The Commission has in place a detailed plan to monitor the performance metrics it has previously approved in regard to BellSouth's OSS and to enforce failures to comply with such metrics. In this docket, BellSouth seeks approval of a new performance-based assessment plan despite the fact that a Commission-approved plan is already in place. Therefore, any action taken by the Commission in this proceeding will directly affect Covad's substantial interests.

6. <u>Ultimate Facts Alleged.</u> BellSouth has not demonstrated that the currently approved performance plan should be replaced.
