COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On July 15, 2004, BellSouth filed its Responses to the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Request related to the status of local competition in Florida. BellSouth's Responses to the Commission's Request, Item Nos. 1, 4, 5 and 6 produced on a proprietary CD-ROM, contain information that is proprietary to BellSouth. In addition, on July 15, 2004 BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.

2. On July 19, 2004, BellSouth filed its First Supplemental Response to the Commission's Request related to the status of local competition in Florida. BellSouth's Supplemental Response to the Commission's Request, Item No. 1 produced on a proprietary CD-ROM, contains information that is proprietary to BellSouth. Furthermore, on July 19, 2004 BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.

3. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), BellSouth hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information contained on the CD-ROMs in BellSouth's Responses and Supplemental Response to the Commission's Request, Item No. 1, 4, 5, and 6, include proprietary data relating to confidential information of competing local exchange carriers

that is protected under the FCC's Customer Proprietary Network Information Rules and confidential business information utilized by BellSouth to conduct business. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of such information would disadvantage BellSouth's customers and potentially harm their ability to compete in the telecommunications market. Additionally, the disclosure of this information would cause competitive harm to BellSouth and provide competitors with an unfair advantage. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential, customer proprietary information pursuant to Section 364.24 and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

4. Attachment A to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.

5. Attachment B to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification is two CD-ROMs which include redacted copies of the document containing the confidential information.

6. Attachment C to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification is the CD-ROM which includes a highlighted copy of the document containing the confidential information.

7. The original of this Request was filed today with the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission enter an order declaring the information

described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
