Re: Delinquent 2003 Annual Report and Associated Penalties

Dear Mr. Hein:

I am writing to inform you that the Commission received the utility's 2003 Annual Report on December 16, 2004; therefore, this letter serves to modify the Commission's letter to East Marion Sanitary Systems, Inc., dated January 5, 2005.

Pursuant to Rule 25-30.110(3), Florida Administrative Code, annual reports are due on March 31 of each year. East Marion Sanitary Systems, Inc. requested and was granted an extension, making the 2003 annual report due on May 31, 2004. Because the utility failed to file the annual report in a timely manner, the utility has accrued penalties, as provided by Rule 25-30.110(6) and (7), Florida Administrative Code. Rule 25-30.110(7)(b), Florida Administrative Code, states, in part, "the penalty for delinquent annual reports shall accrue based on the utility's classification..." The applicable penalty for East Marion Sanitary Systems, Inc., as a Class C utility, is set forth below.
