On February 2, 2005, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-05-0133-PAA-TI, made final and effective by Consummating Order (CO) No. PSC-05-0228-CO-TI, issued on February 28, 2005, in Docket No. 041362-TI. The PAA Order directed Supra Telecommunications and Information Systems, Inc. (Supra) to credit affected customers' accounts for amounts overcharged for the Universal Service Fund contribution, plus interest, and to submit a report within 30 days of the issuance of the CO. The PAA Order also directed Supra to remit any unrefundable monies to the Commission for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund.

Supra submitted its final report and a check in the amount of \$5,393.16 to the Commission on March 31, 2005. Staff reviewed Supra's submission and determined that Supra has complied with all of the terms of the PAA Order. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
