As a result of the Commission's vote at the April 5, 2005 Agenda conference, please provide a statement from the utility that its books and records are being maintained in accordance with the NARUC system of accounts and a statement that the utility's books have been adjusted to reflect the approved rate base adjustments and balances as of December 31, 2003, by June 25, 2005. The approved balances for plant and accumulated depreciation are shown by NARUC accounts in Schedule No. 3 of staff's recommendation and the Proposed Agency Action order that will soon be issued.

The utility was also required to file a revised legal description, territory map and supporting documentation that confirms the revised legal description is consistent with the territory description in Docket No. 760618-W by August 25, 2005. Please contact Stan Rieger if you have any questions about this requirement.
