On November 16, 2004, Docket No. 041314-TI was established to investigate Inter Con Communications' (ICC) apparent violation of Sections 364.02 and 364.04, Florida Statutes. By Order No. PSC-05-0152-PAA-TI, issued February 8, 2005, the Commission penalized ICC in the amount of \$25,000 for its willful violations of Sections 364.02 and 364.04, Florida Statutes. The Order became final and effective upon the issuance of Order No. PSC-05-0249-CO-TI, issued March 4, 2005. The Commission further ordered in the event ICC did not pay the penalty within fourteen calendar days of the issuance of the Consummating Order that staff would refer the penalty to the Department of Financial Service and this docket would be closed administratively.

Fourteen calendar days have elapsed since the issuance of the Consummating Order and the company's payment has not been received. Staff has referred the \$25,000 penalty to the Department of Financial Services for collection; therefore, this docket should be closed administratively. $0k \neq 0$ closed $5/0^{-}/05$ has
