Re: Request for State Waiver for New Code

SBC Telecom (SBCT), Inc., respectfully submits this request for approval of a State Waiver to obtain a code from NeuStar, Inc., for the purpose of providing service for the University of Southern Florida in the St. Petersburg rate center. The customer has requested a specific NPA/NXX, with the 2, 4, and 5 blocks. SBCT will donate the remaining blocks (0, 1, 3, 6 thru 9) to the pool.

A copy of the PAS session is enclosed with this request. SBCT has consulted Gary Zahn of NeuStar on how to proceed with this request, and he has advised that we create the PAS submission without a Part 3 Denial, as we will continue with the PAS request for the code upon approval from this Commission. The PAS Part 1A, MTE (Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet - TN Level), and Part 1B for each of the three blocks are enclosed with this request. A Part 1 Code Request, containing the information for the code that the customer has requested, is also enclosed with this request.

SBCT currently has one block assigned in this rate center; the 727-623-4 block was established in October, 2004. Although we do not meet utilization threshold nor months to exhaust utilization at this time, it is necessary to obtain the NPA/NXX and blocks that the customer has requested.
