Dr. Daniel Borislow currently serves as the Chairman, Chief Executive Officer, President and Director of YMax Communications Corp. and resides in Palm Beach, Florida. He is a graduate of Widener University and is a Doctor of Information Technology. From May 1989 through January 1999, Dr. Borislow served as CEO and a Director of Tel-Save Holdings now Talk America. Tel-Save was a very profitable corporation. As the largest reseller and customer of AT&T, Tel-Save offered wholesale long distance to other resellers through marketing and partnership agreements. Dr. Borislow took his company public in 1995 and built his own long distance network by strategically deploying five (5) Lucent class 5E switches across the United States. Prior to founding Tel-Save Incorporated, Dr. Borislow built the cable systems in the city of Philadelphia.
