JOINT STATUS REPORT ON PHASE 2 ISSUES

DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company (Covad), Florida Digital Network, Inc., d/b/a FDN Communications (FDN), and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) (jointly, Parties) report¹ on negotiations regarding the issues in Phase 2 of this proceeding.

1. The Order Establishing Procedure, Order No. PSC-05-0433-PCO-TP (OEP), divided the issues in this docket into two phases. The OEP set pertinent procedural deadlines for the Phase 1 issues. In addition, it directed the parties to continue to negotiate on the Phase 2 issues, which deal with line splitting and line sharing.² The OEP also directed the parties to report to the Prehearing Officer on the status of such negotiations within 60 days of the issuance of the OEP.

2. This pleading is filed in compliance with that requirement.

¹ This pleading is filed by Covad, FDN and BellSouth. These are the only entities that have been involved in negotiations on Phase 2 issues.

² Covad and BellSouth currently have a motion pending to move Issue 17, relating to loop sharing, to Phase 2.

3. Thus, far the Parties have held two meetings to discuss Phase 2 issues. These meetings were held on May 6, 2004 and June 9, 2005. Additional meetings will be planned as needed by the parties.

4. Progress is being made toward resolution of the Phase 2 issues. Therefore, the Parties request that they be given an additional 60 days to negotiate and that no procedural dates be set for Phase 2 issues at this time.
