On October 29, 2004, Docket No. 041266-TP was established to address the cancellation of International Exchange Communications, Inc. d/b/a IE Com's ("IE Com" or "company") intrastate interexchange telecommunications company (IXC) Registration No. TJ184 and competitive local exchange telecommunications company (CLEC) Certificate No. 4852 due to Chapter 11 bankruptcy.

By Order No. PSC-05-0561-PAA-TP, the Commission approved the cancellation of IE Com's IXC Registration No. TJ184 and CLEC Certificate No. 4852, effective October 29, 2004. The Commission further ordered that Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) for the years 2002, 2003, and 2004 for the company's IXC registration and CLEC certificate, as well as the statutory late payment charges for the years 1999, 2000, 2002, and 2003 for the company's IXC registration, and the statutory late payment charges for the years 1997, 2000, and 2003 for the company's CLEC certificate, shall not be sent to the Florida Department of Financial Services for collection. Furthermore, IE Com was ordered to immediately cease and desist providing IXC services in Florida.

Therefore, staff requests that the Bureau of Administrative Services/Fiscal Services Section take the appropriate steps to seek permission from the Department of Financial Services to write-off the uncollectible RAFs for the years 2002, 2003, and 2004, for IE Com's IXC registration and CLEC certificate, as well as the statutory late payment charges for the years
