NOTICE is hereby given that the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission will conduct a workshop, to which all persons are invited, at the following time and place:

PURPOSE

The purpose of this workshop is to discuss the implementation of a three-digit toll-free number for Florida's "One Call" notification system for providing advanced notice of excavation activities to underground facility operators as required by the Pipeline Safety Improvement Act of 2002. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC), requires all telecommunications carriers, including wireline, wireless, and payphone service providers to deploy the 811 code for use as a "One call" dig number for excavation work by April 13, 2007.

The FCC delegated authority to state commissions, pursuant to section 251(e), to address the technical and operational issues associated with the implementation of 811.² Commission staff is attempting to determine the level of assistance needed, if any, by the industry with the implementation of 811. Staff believes a dialogue between wireline, wireless, and payphone providers, along with the Sunshine State One-Call of Florida, may identify potential problems and assist with the implementation.
