Section VI, prefiled testimony and 14 exhibits. Section VII, order of witnesses. 15 MS. SMITH: Commissioner, FPL believes that the 16 17 appearance of Steven Sim, he's a direct and rebuttal witness, we believe that his appearance could be combined into one 18 19 appearance. COMMISSIONER DEASON: You propose then to, for 20 Witness Sim, to do the direct and rebuttal at the same time? 21 22 MS. SMITH: Yes, sir. COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. Any objection to doing 23 that?

BROWN: Staff has no questions for those 15 16 witnesses and would agree to stipulate their testimony into the record. 17 18 MR. TAIT: Without a cross there's no redirect, and I have no --19 20 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. Ms. Brown, show 21 then that those witnesses will be -- do this. We need to ask 22 the other Commissioners whether they have questions. And

assuming they do not, well, then those witnesses can be excused
