On February 10, 1982, Florida Power Corporation (now Progress Energy Florida, Inc.) filed a confidential document described as "International Marine Terminals Agreement Audit Report (initial escalation through 4/1/80 escalation)". The document was logged in under a numbering system for confidential documents as Document No. EFC-25 and placed in confidential storage. On April 22, 1985 a ruling on confidentiality in the form of a letter to the company was issued by the Division of Appeals.

During a recent audit of all confidential documents on file (which included entry of pre-1989 confidential filings in CMS for better tracking of the documents) I determined Document EFC-25 was not in the files, and further review of sign-out records revealed that, on September 14, 1990, the document was signed out by a then-PSC-attorney, Barb Balzer, and was not returned to the Division prior to her departure from the Commission.

I then contacted Mary Anne Helton in the General Counsel's Office to ask if the document might still be in that Office's files. After a search of files, she advised no one had seen the document. I also checked with Bob Freeman, who is independently tracking this audit-related document during its required 25-year retention, and was advised he does not have the document or a copy of the document.
