Cost Recovery Factors

Q. What is the composite effect of Tampa Electric's proposed changes in its capacity, fuel and purchased power, environmental and energy conservation cost recovery factors on a 1,000 kWh residential customer's bill?

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Α. Given the unprecedented increases in fuel commodity prices and purchased power costs, Tampa Electric implemented a strategy in 2005 to sell available SO2 allowances to help mitigate some of the impact of rising fuel and purchased power prices. This is described in more detail in witnesses H. T. Bryant's and G. M. Nelson's testimonies filed in Docket No. 050007-EI. Even with the SO₂ allowance sales, as well as the prudent procurement practices and hedging strategies described by witness J. T. Wehle, the composite effect residential bill for 1,000 kWh is an increase of \$11.54 beginning January 2006. These charges are shown Exhibit ___ (CA-3), Document No. 3.

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Q. When should the new rates go into effect?

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A. The new rates should go into effect concurrent with the first billing cycle for January 2006.
