**Subject: VERIZON REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF NUMBER DENIAL**

Dear Ms. Bayo:

On November 3, 2005, Verizon applied to the Pooling Administrator (PA) for a single 1,000 block of numbers to assign to new and existing customers in the Poinciana rate center. The application, however, was denied on November 4, 2005 because Verizon's application did not satisfy the Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization criteria for the Haines City rate center.

Currently, the LERG identifies Poinciana as part of the Haines City rate center. Verizon is in the process of correcting the LERG to recognize Poinciana as a separate rate center within the Haines City exchange, consistent with Verizon's tariffs. Verizon has initiated this process in order to establish correct call routing and rating for all Haines City and Poinciana customers. To ensure correct call routing and rating, Verizon must assign numbers associated with the Poinciana rate center to Poinciana customers. Poinciana's NXX code is exhausting, and thus Verizon asked the PA for an additional 1,000 block of numbers for the Poinciana rate center. However, because the LERG still identifies Poinciana as part of the Haines City rate center, and the Haines City codes are not exhausting, NeuStar denied Verizon's request for numbers to relieve the Poinciana number shortage. Unless Verizon obtains relief from the Florida Public Service Commission, Verizon will have to continue to assign numbers from the Haines City rate center to serve new and existing Poinciana customers using porting technology.

Verizon requests that the Commission use its delegated authority to waive the Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization requirements so that Verizon may be assigned the required 1,000 block of numbers.
