REQUEST OF FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF HEARING EXHIBIT 91

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C., and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, hereby requests confidential classification of certain information contained in Hearing Exhibit 91 ("HE 91"), which was made part of the record of the hearing held in the above docket on November 7-9, 2005 (the "Hearing"). In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

1. HE 91, entitled "Two-Year O&M Request Versus Target," consists of three pages, Bates numbered FCR-00437, 00470 and 00471, that were produced to the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") in response to OPC's Third Request for Production of Documents. Those pages were designated as confidential at the time of production to OPC and were the subject of a motion for temporary protective order filed by FPL on October 20, 2005, which was granted by Order No. PSC-05-1083-PCO-EI, dated November 2, 2005. OPC informed FPL that it intended to use the three pages at the Hearing. FPL filed a motion for protective order, dated November 4, 2005, concerning their use, which was granted by the Commission orally at the beginning of the Hearing. Tr. 12. During the Hearing, OPC had the three pages marked as HE 91, which was admitted into the record. This Request is being made within twenty-one days following the Hearing and is intended to request confidential classification of HE 91 as part of the Commission's record in this docket, consistent with Rule 25-22.006(8).

- 2. The following exhibits, which are included herewith and made a part hereof, document and support this Request:
- a. Composite Exhibit A is a copy of HE 91 on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted. Composite Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed folder marked "CONFIDENTIAL."
- b. Composite Exhibit B is an edited version of HE 91 on which all information FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been reducted.
- c. Exhibit C is a table containing a line-by-line and page-by-page identification of the information for which confidential treatment is sought, together with references to the specific statutory basis for the claim of confidentiality.
- d. Exhibit D is the affidavit of Walter E. Gwinn, who attests to the basis for FPL's requesting confidential classification.
- 3. The information highlighted in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3). Pursuant to section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information: (a) the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information; and (b) the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See §366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that this Request be granted.
