On May 20, 2005, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-05-0548-PAA-TX (the PAA Order) in Docket No. 050181-TX, as amended by Amendatory Orders PSC-05-0548A-PAA-TX and PSC-05-0548B-PAA-TX, issued on July 13 and July 27, 2005, respectively, and made final and effective by Consummating Order No. PSC-05-0636-CO-TX, issued on June 13, 2005, imposing penalties in the amount of \$10,500 for failure to comply with Commission rules and ordering the company to pay its outstanding Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) with statutory late payment charges, to be paid within 14 days of the issuance of the Consummating Order. The company has neither protested the Commission's Order nor paid the penalties, RAFs, and statutory late payment charges. In accordance with the PAA Order, as amended, the RAFs and statutory late payment charges were referred to the Department of Financial Services on November 16, 2005. Therefore, the company's competitive local exchange telecommunications company certificate no. 8234 should be canceled effective June 27, 2005, and this docket should be closed administratively.
