

NOTICE OF RATE CHANGE

Water Management Services, Inc. (Utility) requested a rate increase to cover the cost of installing a new water transmission main to St. George Island. The new water transmission main was required because the Department of Transportation built a new bridge to the island and demolished the bridge to which the Utility's original water transmission main was attached. Two tiers of temporary increases described as Phase 1 and Phase 2 were approved by the PSC. The project is complete and all costs have been verified. Accordingly, Phase 3, a true-up setting final rates, has been approved.

The rates were reduced for the first twelve months to recover an over-earning from the previously approved rates. These rates, which will be in effect for the first 12 months after the Commission has approved new tariff sheets, are shown in column "A." The rates which will be in effect after the twelve-month period are shown in column "B."
