By letter received November 14, 2005, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed a request for approval of an amendment to the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement with NationsLine Florida, Inc. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was February 13, 2006.
