The Commission should approve PGS's final PGA true-up amount of \$10,786,747 (underrecovery) for the period January 2005 through December 2005; its estimated PGA true-up amount of \$15,611,711 (overrecovery) for the period January - December 2006; and its levelized PGA (cap) factor of \$1.34870 per therm for the period January 1 through December 31, 2007. PGS: \$15,611,711 overrecovery (Elliott)

PGS: \$4,824,964 overrecovery (Elliott)

Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2007, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2007, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment charge became effective.
