FPU has properly projected its true-up amounts and projected gas costs. Its costs and projections are reasonable and its purchased gas cost recovery factors should be approved by the Commission.

<u>Issue 1</u>: What is the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January, 2005 through December, 2005?

FPU's Position: \$1,480,240 (underrecovery)

<u>Issue 2</u>: What is the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January, 2006 through December, 2006?

<u>FPU's Position</u>: \$3,894,424 (overrecovery)

- <u>Issue 3</u>: What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be refunded in the January, 2007 through December, 2007 period?
- <u>FPU's Position</u>: \$2,414,184 (overrecovery)
- **<u>Issue 4</u>**: What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factor to be charged during the period January, 2007 through December, 2007?
- FPU's Position: 151.800 cents per therm.
- **<u>Issue 5</u>**: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?
- <u>FPU's Position</u>: The factor should be effective for all meter readings on or after January, 2007, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for the period January, 2007 through December, 2007.
