## Citizens' Request for Oral Argument

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.058, Florida Administrative Code, the Citizens of Florida, through Harold McLean, Public Counsel, request the opportunity to present oral argument on the Citizens' Motion for Clarification and Reconsideration of Order No. PSC-06-1057-FOF-El which accompanies this request.

Oral argument will aid the Commission in comprehending and evaluating a possible unintended consequence of its order. The order could be read to change an issue in the case from one of responsibility by Florida Power and Light Company for an extended outage at its Turkey Point nuclear facility to one of prudence, even though no party argued to the Commission that the issue should be limited in this manner. The Commission has broad authority and responsibility under chapter 366, Florida Statutes, to set rates which are fair, just and reasonable. While the company's prudence is one aspect of whether rates are fair, just and reasonable, the term "fair, just and reasonable" is broader than just prudence. Oral argument will assist the Commission in distinguishing between the two concepts.
