Pursuant to Section 366.076, Florida Statutes, Florida Public Utilities Company is seeking approval for a revision to its current base rates in order to recover the costs associated with nuplementing storm preparedness programs required by the Florida Public Service Commission in Docket No. 060198-EI. These programs were not in existence or anticipated when the base rates of the Company were last established, and the significant, unanticipated annual costs of these programs, projected to be \$713,517 in,2007, would have an adverse effect on the financial position of the Company.
