AT&T LD will discontinue ETFS throughout the continental United States.

### Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

Enhanced Toll Free Service is a suite of advanced toll free service features that allows the customer to specifically define how incoming calls are handled, routed and billed.

As a result of the acquisition of AT&T Corp. and its affiliated companies by SBC Communications Inc., the combined entity, AT&T Inc., is streamlining its service portfolio. If this Application is approved, the service described above, currently provided by AT&T LD, will be provided by another affiliate of AT&T Inc.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by this service discontinuance because there are many alternative providers of toll free services, including but not limited to AT&T Corp. Furthermore, none of the affected customers should experience a loss in service as AT&T Inc. plans to offer comparable services to these customers through another AT&T affiliate.

# Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(3)):

AT&T LD notified customers by letter sent via U.S. Mail on May 25, 2007. A copy of the letter is attached hereto as Attachment A.

Copies of this Application are being sent, first class U.S. Mail, to the public utilities commission and governor of the states where AT&T LD will discontinue this service and also to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.

### Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

AT&T LD is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.
