Customer Meetings Scheduled to Discuss Petition for Storm Cost Recovery Clause By Florida Public Utilities Company

TALLAHASSEE — The members and staff of the Florida Public Service Commission will conduct two customer service hearings on Monday, June 27, 2005, to provide consumers an opportunity to comment on a request by Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) to recover costs associated with the 2004 hurricane season.

The company is seeking permission to recover \$860,000 from its 48,000 natural gas customers in its service area in South and Central Florida. According to company estimates, total damage from Hurricanes Charley, Frances, and Jeanne was estimated at \$619,227. Prior to the storms, FPUC had a Storm Damage Reserve balance of \$59,070. After the storm damage charges are applied, the Storm Damage Reserve will have a negative balance of approximately \$560,157. FPUC is requesting recovery of the \$560,157 negative balance plus an additional \$299,843 to replenish its Storm Damage Reserve. FPUC seeks to recover the total \$860,000 over a four year period. The impact to the average residential customer bill (25 therms per month) is expected to be \$0.19.



In December of 2004, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC or the company) filed a petition with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) for approval of a Storm Cost Recovery Clause for the recovery of extraordinary expenditures related to Hurricanes Charley, Frances, and Jeanne. FPUC petitioned the Commission to recover the storm damage costs over a period of four years. The purpose of the new clause would be to recover the storm damage costs in excess of the amount contained in the utility's Storm Damage Reserve.

FPUC serves approximately 48,000 natural gas customers in its service area in South and Central Florida. Its service area encompasses the counties of Palm Beach, Broward, Seminole, and Volusia.

The storm related costs experienced by FPUC are currently estimated at \$619,227. Prior to the storms, FPUC had a Storm Damage Reserve balance of \$59,070. After the storm damage charges are applied, the Storm Damage Reserve will have a negative balance of approximately \$560,157. FPUC is requesting recovery of the \$560,157 negative balance plus an additional \$299,843 to replenish its Storm Damage Reserve. FPUC is proposing to recover the total \$860,000 amount over a four year period. The impact to the average residential customer bill (25 therms per month) is expected to be \$0.19.

The PSC has scheduled two customer meetings to receive customer testimony regarding the utility's

petition to implement a Storm Cost Recovery Clause and to receive comments on the utility's recovery efforts for each hurricane event. In accordance with Florida Statutes, the PSC will consider the utility's quality of service and other matters in this case.

PSC staff is scheduled to file a recommendation with the Commission on August 18, 2005. The Commissioners are expected to vote on this matter at the August 30, 2005, Agenda Conference.
