On June 26, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed its Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), for-certain information contained in **FPSC Document No. 05095-07**: AT&T Florida's response to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories (No. 18) and Attachments responding to Staff's First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 3, 45, 6, 7, 13, 14, 16, and 17).

On July 17, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its <u>Request For Specified Confidential Classification</u> pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 05095-07. Attached to its request, AT&T Florida submitted another copy of the documents previously identified as FPSC Document No. 05095-07: the second copy was identified as **FPSC Document No. 06004-07**.

AT&T Florida claims the information in Document Nos. 05095-07 and 06004-07 for
which confidential classification is requested contains confidential business information related
to competitive interests utilized by AT&T Florida to conduct its business and has not been
disclosed to the public. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would
cause harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential
——elassification contains AT&T Florida's financial analysis and cost projections related to the
provision of service to two subdivisions within its service territory. The financial information
includes AT&T Florida's costs for deployment of its network; its net present value calculations
and cumulative cash flow analysis; its revenue and line counts of customers who have bundles
and/or features; its average revenue per customer; and detailed budget, accounting, and strategic
information for the company. The information also include trade secrets related to internal
network methods and procedures, network design standards, and guidelines for the installation of
certain network elements.
