On July 9, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed its <u>Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification</u> pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), for certain information contained in **FPSC Document No. 05741-07**: AT&T Florida's Response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories (No. 31) and *Supplemental* Response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories (No. 31).

On July 19, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its <u>Request For Specified Confidential</u> <u>Classification</u> pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 05741-07. Attached to its request, AT&T Florida submitted another copy of the documents previously identified as FPSC Document No. 05741-07: the second copy was identified as **FPSC Document No. 06147-07**.

CMP \_\_\_\_\_\_AT&T Florida claims the information in Document Nos. 05741-07 and 06147-07 for which confidential classification is requested contains confidential business information related to competitive interests utilized by AT&T Florida to conduct its business and has not been CTR \_\_\_\_\_\_disclosed to the public. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would impair the competitive business and cause harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification pertains to AT&T Florida's net present value and GCL \_\_\_\_\_\_unulative cash flow analysis related to the revenues generated from the provision of service to two subdivisions within is service territory.
