Beach exchange by AT&T.

On July 25, 2007, AT&T Florida, Inc., (AT&T) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Delray Beach Kings Point (DLBHFLKPDS0) switch. AT&T requested a block specifically to meet the request of a specific customer for 300 numbers in at least blocks of 100. On July 25, 2007, AT&T's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust and utilization criteria.

On August 1, 2007, AT&T filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the AT&T petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources:
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (August 15, 2007), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide AT&T the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Delray Beach Kings Faint (DLBHFLKPDS0) switch.
