2	Q.	Please state your name and business address.
3	A.	Keith Kleinmann, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, 2295 Victoria
4		Avenue, Suite 364, Fort Myers, Florida 33902.
5	Q.	Please state a brief description of your educational background and experience.
6	A.	I have a Bachelor of Science Degree from the Florida Southern College and have been
7		an employee of the Department of Environmental Protection for over 13 years; the vast
8		majority of that time was in the Wastewater Section.
9	Q.	By whom are you presently employed?
10	A.	Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP)
11	Q.	How long have you been employed with the FDEP and in what capacity?
12	A.	I have been an employee of the Department of Environmental Protection for 13 years;
13		the vast majority of that time was in the Wastewater Section. Duties include
14		enforcement coordinator for all wastewater related enforcement activities in the South
15		District. I oversee the compliance section of the Wastewater Section. We conduct
16		inspections, review all compliance data related to wastewater quality and ensure that
17		all violations are corrected in a timely manner.
18	Q.	What are your general responsibilities at the FDEP?
19	A.	I am the Environmental Manager of five employees of the compliance enforcement
20		section of the Wastewater Section.
21	Q.	Are you familiar with Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc.'s (utility) wastewater systems in
22		Highlands and Lee Counties, particularly the wastewater treatment system in
23		Highlands County, including Leisure Lakes, and the wastewater treatment system in
24		Lee County, including South Seas?
25	A.	Yes.

Does the utility have appropriate current permits from the FDEP? 1 Q. 2 A. Yes. Do all the systems have a valid operating permit? 3 Q. Yes. 4 A. 5 Q. Please state the issuance date and the expiration date of any construction permits. 6 A. Leisure Lakes has a current Permit No. FLA014388 that was issued on July 28, 2004 and expires on July 27 2009. 7 South Seas has a current Permit No. FLA014686 that was issued on June 22, 2005, 8 9 revised on March 28 2007, and expires June 21, 2010. Is the utility in compliance with its permits? 10 Q. Leisure Lakes is in compliance with its permit. South Sea is not in compliance with 11 A. 12 the Department. The Department currently has a Consent Order against them. From 13 June 22, 2005 to October 13, 2005, South Seas discharged to two golf course ponds 14 that are not authorized discharge sites. Are the wastewater collection, treatment and disposal facilities adequate to serve 15 Q. 16 present customers based on permitted capacity? 17 A. Yes. 18 Q. Has FDEP required the utility to take any action so as to minimize possible adverse 19 effects resulting from odors, noise, aerosol drift or lighting? 20 No. A. 21 Q. Do pump stations and lift stations meet FDEP requirements with respect to location, 22 reliability and safety? 23 A. Yes. 24 Q. Does the utility have certified operators as required by Chapter 62-602, Florida 25 Administrative Code?

Yes. 1 A. 2 Q. Is the overall maintenance of the treatment, collection, and disposal facilities 3 satisfactory? 4 A. Yes Does the utility meet all applicable technology based effluent limitations (TBELS) and 5 Q. water quality based effluent limitations (WQBELS)? 6 Yes. 7 A. Does the facility meet the effluent disposal requirements of Rules 62-611 and 62-8 Q. 9 600.530, Florida Administrative Code? 10 Yes. A. Are the collection, treatment and disposal facilities in compliance with all other 11 Q. 12 provisions of Chapter 62, Florida Administrative Code, not previously mentioned? 13 A. Yes. Has the utility been the subject of any FDEP enforcement action within the past two 14 Q. 15 years? 16 Yes.
