

On August 9, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its request pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, for confidential classification and treatment of the information contained in FPSC Document Number 06275-07, which is Exhibit PAT-3 that was attached to AT&T witness Pam Tipton's direct testimony. AT&T claims that the information contained in this document is proprietary for the following reasons:

The information contained in testimony exhibit PAT-3 includes confidential business information that could cause competitive harm to dPi and or AT&T Florida, and such information is confidential and proprietary. Public disclosure of this information would provide competitors of AT&T Florida and dPi with an unfair marketing advantage. Such proprietary information is not available to the general public. The information discussed in this request for specified confidential classification is valuable and both AT&T Florida and dPi strive to keep it secret. Consequently, this information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes and is exempt from public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

Upon review of the information contained in the documents, technical staff concurs with AT&T Florida that the information meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 354.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, and the formation should be treated as confidential.

AT&T FLORIDA'S **REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Sections 364.183 and 364.24, files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On July 23, 2007, AT&T Florida filed the direct testimony of Pam Tipton, along with exhibits PAT-1 through PAT-4, in the above captioned proceeding. Exhibit PAT-3 to Pam Tipton's testimony contains customer specific information for dPi Teleconnect, Inc. that is confidential business information. AT&T Florida filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification regarding this proprietary material on that same day.

2. AT&T Florida hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information contained in its testimony exhibit PAT-3 includes confidential business information that could cause competitive harm to dPi and/or AT&T Florida, and is confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Sections 364.183 and 364.24.

3. Attachment A to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.

4. Attachment B to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification is two redacted copies of the confidential information.

5. Attachment C to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification is a proprietary copy of the confidential information, highlighted to clearly indicate the proprietary material.

6. Public disclosure of this information would provide competitors of AT&T Florida and dPi with an unfair marketing advantage. Such proprietary information is not available to the general public. The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable and both AT&T Florida and dPi strive to keep it secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information and customer proprietary information pursuant to Section 364.24 and Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

6. AT&T Florida has treated, and intends to continue to treat, the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

7. The original of this Request was filed today with the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, AT&T Florida respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
