Good afternoon Mr. Handley.

The PSC has reviewed its need to retain data we received from Progress Energy for the Distribution Reliability Audit conducted in 2003. The materials consisted of: 1 CD with the SAIDI, CAIDI, SAIFI, and MAIFIe; 1 floppy disk with text version of 2002 report, and some associated hard copy data format documentation. These materials were initially identified by Progress as Proprietary and Confidential and have been maintained as such. After communicating with our Staff, it appears that we no longer need the materials and would like to return them to you. have an email to which you were copied on May 29, 2003 from Jim McPherson (Tampa District Audit manager). In that email, Jim indicated that he had apparently been in communication with you and that his understanding was, "the data itself was Not Confidential only the medium and file layout sent". If there have been any changes to the format/system which produced the SAIDI, SAIFI, MAIFIes, and CEMI5, in 2003, it may be a mute issue as to confidentiality but that would be your decision.
