Give us just a moment to let people shift out so that I can be sure, hopefully, that we can 8 all hear. 9 10 (Pause.) Commissioner Carter. 11 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Thank you, Madam Chairman. 12 I just wanted to say publicly about how appreciative 13 I am with Commissioner Skop working with our staff to go back 14 and work again, and with his efforts and the efforts of our 15 staff resulted in a significant savings for the customers. And 16 17 I just wanted to say how much I appreciate the hard work that was done on this. Thank you. 18 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Thank you. And we'll look to our 19 20 staff to give us an overview of the item. 21 MR. CASEY: Good morning, Commissioners. Bob Casey 22 on behalf of staff. 23 Item Number 2 addresses the 2008/2009 contract option year with Sprint to provide Relay service for the nearly 24 25 3 million deaf, hard-of-hearing, deaf/blind and speech-impaired

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citizens in Florida.

2 Staff is recommending that the Commission exercise 3 its contract option to extend the Sprint Relay contract for one 4 year beginning June 1st, 2008. Staff is also recommending that 5 two new members be appointed to the Relay Advisory Committee to 6 replace two members who have resigned.

7 Staff has a few minor changes to its recommendation 8 due to further negotiations with Sprint Relay and an enhanced 9 proposal received September 6th after this recommendation was 10 filed.

On Page 2 in the second full paragraph, the last sentence should now read "After further discussions with staff, Sprint submitted a letter on August 27th, 2007, and another letter on September 6th, 2007, revising its pricing cap options for Years 2 through 4 of the contract period."

16 On Page 3 in Issue 1 we need to strike "August 27, 17 2007," and substitute "September 6th, 2007." Also on Page 3 in 18 the recommendation statement we need to strike "August 27th, 19 2007," and substitute "September 6th, 2007."

On Page 8, at the end of the first paragraph we need to strike "August 27th" and again substitute "September 6th, 2007." Also on Page 8 in the third paragraph we need to strike all references to "August 27th" and substitute "September 6th, 2007."

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Lastly, on Page 9 in the second paragraph we need to
