# FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S MOTION FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER (CORPORATE SECURITY INVESTIGATIVE REPORT)

Pursuant to Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), hereby moves the Commission, through the Prehearing Officer, for a temporary protective order to exempt from Section 119.07(1) the confidential Corporate Security Investigative Report that is attached as Exhibit TOJ-1 to the prepared testimony of FPL witness T.O. Jones (the "Security Report"), and in support states:

- 1. The Office of Public Counsel's ("OPC's") First Request for Production of Documents No. 1 ("Request No. 1") in the above docket asks FPL to produce, *inter alia*, all confidential documents that have been filed in this docket. FPL has recently filed the Security Report and has requested confidential classification of that report. Accordingly, the Security Report is responsive to Request No. 1. OPC has asked FPL to provide a copy of the Security Report.
- 2. FPL seeks confidential protection of the Security Report because it relates to security, and if made public, would disclose certain details about FPL's security measures, system, or procedures to the detriment of FPL, its customers, and the general public. Pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(c), Florida Statutes, such information constitutes proprietary confidential business information and is exempt from Section 119.07(1).

DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

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3. Rule 25-22.006(6)(c) provides in relevant part:

[T]he utility may request a temporary protective order exempting the information from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes. If the information is to be used in a proceeding before the Commission, then the utility must file a specific request for a protective order under paragraph (a) above. If the information is not to be used in a proceeding before the Commission, then Public Counsel shall return the information to the utility in accordance with the record retention requirements of the Department of State.

4. FPL respectfully requests that the Commission enter a temporary protective order affording FPL the protection that is needed in order to allow OPC to take possession of the

5. FPL has been authorized by counsel for OPC to represent that OPC does not
