On September 10, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its request pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, for confidential classification and treatment of the information contained in FPSC Document Number 07383-07, which is AT&T's Responses to Staff's First Request for Production of documents Nos. 3 and 6. AT&T claims that this information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes and exempt from public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

AT&T Florida stats that the above mentioned responses contain information considered confidential business information related to the competitive interests of AT&T Florida that is proprietary to AT&T Florida. Public disclosure of this information would cause competitive harm to AT&T Florida and provide competitors with an unfair marketing advantage because such proprietary information is not available to the general public. The information in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable and AT&T Florida strives to keep it secret.

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On August 20, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its Responses to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1 6) and First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1 7). AT&T Florida's Response to Request for Production Nos. 3 and 6 contain information to be considered confidential business information. A Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification was also filed on that same day.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, AT&T Florida hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the above document contains information considered confidential business information related to the competitive interests of AT&T Florida that is proprietary to AT&T Florida. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.
- 3. Public disclosure of this information would cause competitive harm to AT&T Florida and provide competitors with an unfair advantage. The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is

valuable and AT&T Florida strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.
