COMES NOW, Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and submits this Request for Confidential Classification of information contained in FPUC's Preliminary List of Issues and Positions filed in this docket. In support of this Request, FPUC would state:

- 1. On September 5, 2007, FPUC filed its testimony and exhibits in support of the purchased power cost recovery factor to be applied to customer bills in 2008. Accompanying that filing was a request for confidential treatment of portions of the schedules and testimony on the basis that the identified information consisted of contractual data and information relating to competitive interests and thus exempt from disclosure pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Elorida Statutes. A ruling on that request is pending.

competitively bid. Costs to FPUC under the Agreement reflect the results of negotiations

favorable terms. The numbers are considered to be and are treated as confidential proprietary

business information pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e). In addition to the foregoing
