**FPUC's Position:**

Residential	\$.07231
General Service	\$.03160
Large Volume Service	\$.02190
Large Volume Transportation Service	\$.02190

**Issue 3:**        **What should be the effective date of the conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?**

**FPUC's Position:**     The conservation cost recovery factors should be effective for the period January, 2008 through December, 2008, and to billings thereafter until other conservation cost recovery factors are approved by the Commission.


