PROGRESS ENERGY FLORIDA INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Progress Energy Florida, Inc., ("PEF" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Request for Confidential Classification for certain information provided in response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 11-20) propounded on PEF. In support of this Request, PEF states:

- 1. In response to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories, PEF will provide responses containing information that is "proprietary business information" under Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes.
 - 2. The following exhibits are included with this request:
- Sealed Composite Exhibit A is a package containing unredacted copies of all (a) CMP **COM** _____the documents for which PEF seeks confidential treatment. Composite Exhibit A is being submitted CTR separately in a sealed envelope labeled "CONFIDENTIAL." In the unredacted versions, the ECR GCL <u>_____information asserted to be confidential is highlighted by yellow marker.</u>
- OPC Composite Exhibit B is a package containing two copies of redacted versions (b) RCA of the documents for which the Company requests confidential classification. The specific SCR SGA

(c) Exhibit C is a table which identifies by page and line the information for which PEF seeks confidential classification and the specific statutory bases for seeking confidential treatment.

3. As indicated in Exhibit C, the information for which PEF requests confidential classification is "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S. Specifically, the information at issue relates to competitively negotiated data, such as pricing and quantities of fuels, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the Company or its affiliates to negotiate fuel supply contracts on favorable terms. *See* § 366.093(3)(d), F.S.; Affidavit of Alexander Weintraub at ¶ 5. Furthermore, the information at issue relates to the competitive interests of PEF and its fuel suppliers, the disclosure of which would impair their competitive businesses. *Id.* § 366.093(3)(e); Affidavit of Alexander Weintraub at ¶ 6. Accordingly, such information constitutes "proprietary confidential business information" which is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act pursuant to Section 366.093(1), F.S.

4. The information identified as Exhibit "A" is intended to be and is treated as confidential by the Company. See Affidavit of Alexander Weintraub at \P 7. The information has not been disclosed to the public, and the Company has treated and continues to treat the information and contracts at issue as confidential. See Affidavit of Alexander Weintraub at \P 7.

5. PEF requests that the information identified in Exhibit A be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of section 366.093(3), F.S., that the information remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in section 366.093(4)

F.S., and that the information be returned as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business..

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, PEF respectfully requests that this Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
