3. As indicated in Exhibit C, the information for which PEF requests

confidential classification is "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S. Specifically, the information at issue is confidential internal processes, the disclosure of which could jeopardize PEF's ability to effectively evaluate and adjust claims. *See* § 366.093(3)(e), F.S.; Affidavit of Thomas Currier at ¶ 5. Accordingly, such information constitutes "proprietary confidential business information" which is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act pursuant to Section 366.093(1), F.S.

4. The information identified as Exhibit "A" is intended to be and is treated as confidential by the Company. See Affidavit of Thomas Currier at \P 6. The information has not been disclosed to the public, and the Company has treated and continues to treat the information at issue as confidential. See Affidavit of Thomas Currier at \P 6.

5. PEF requests that the information identified in Exhibit A be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of section 366.093(3), F.S., that the information remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in section 366.093(4) F.S., and that the information be returned as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, PEF respectfully requests that this Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
