

On September 28, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its request pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, for confidential classification and treatment of the information contained in FPSC Document Number 08633-07, which is AT&T's Responses to Staff's Second Request for Production of Documents Nos. 7-11. AT&T claims that certain portions of the response to Request No. 10 should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), and Section 364.24, Florida Statutes, and exempt from public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

AT&T Florida states that certain portions of the information contained in response to No. 10 includes customer specific information that is confidential and proprietary. Specifically, this information reflects AT&T customer telephone numbers; public disclosure of such would be in contravention of the above referenced statutory provisions, and would result in the public disclosure of private information regarding subscribers. AT&T Florida has treated, and intends to continue to treat, the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not be generally disclosed.
