Subject: Request to make Oral Modification

Dr. Bane,

Staff would like to request permission to modify Item 8 (Docket No. 000121C-TP) at next Tuesday's Agenda (October 23) , as shown in type and strike below. The modification is to Issue 2 (Close Docket Issue) of the recommendation.

The recommendation addresses revisions to Verizon's Performance Assessment Plan. As filed, staff is *not* recommending that a Proposed Agency Action Order be issued because interested persons had 15 days to file objections to Verizon's proposed revisions and none were received by the Commission.

However, upon further review of the Joint Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, staff noted that the Agreement actually requires the Commission to issues a Proposed Agency Action approving the proposed revisions. Accordingly, staff would like to modify Issue 2 to require issuance of a Proposed Agency Action if the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issue 1. This will allow interested persons an additional 21 days to object to proposed revisions to Verizon's Performance Assessment Plan.

If no person whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within 21 days of the issuance date of the Order, the Order should become final upon the issuance of a Consummating Order. Thereafter, this docket should remain open for the Commission to conduct periodic reviews of Verizon's Performance Measurement Plan and to complete any initial third-party audit outlined in Order No. PSC-03-0761-PAA-TP.

Verizon has been notified of this requested modification.
