

AFFIDAVIT OF RANDALL R. LABAUVE


BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Randall R. LaBauve who, being first duly sworn deposes and says:

1. My name is Randall R. LaBauve I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") as Vice President of Environmental Services in the General Counsel Business Unit. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. I have reviewed the document and information for which I am listed as an affiant in Exhibit C and which are included in Exhibit A to FPL's Request for Confidential Classification. The information in Exhibit A which is asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information contains or constitutes contractual data, such as pricing and other terms, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Similarly, disclosure of the information could impair the competitive business of the counter party of service. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of the information in Exhibit A which is asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information.


