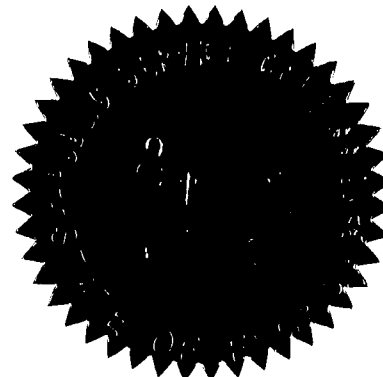

3 Public Service Commission Staff.

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P R O C E E D I N G S

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2 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Item 8, we have an oral
3 modification.

4 MR. TEITZMAN: Good morning, Commissioners. Adam
5 Teitzman on behalf of Commission staff.

6 Commissioners, staff's recommendation in
7 Item 8 addresses revisions to Verizon's performance assessment
8 plan. As filed, staff did not recommend that a Proposed Agency
9 Action order be issued because interested persons had 15 days
10 to file objections to Verizon's proposed revisions, and none
11 were received by the Commission.

12 However, upon further review of the joint settlement
13 agreement approved by this Commission, staff noted that the
14 agreement actually requires the Commission to issue a Proposed
15 Agency Action approving the proposed revisions. Accordingly,
16 staff would like to modify Issue 2 to require issuance of a
17 Proposed Agency Action if the Commission approves staff's
18 recommendation in Issue 1. This would allow interested persons
19 an additional 21 days to object to proposed revisions to
20 Verizon's performance assessment plan.

21 The following sentence should be inserted at the
22 beginning of Issue 2's recommendation statement. "If no person
23 whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within
24 21 days of the issuance date of the order, the order should
25 become final upon the issuance of a consummating order."

1 And then the next sentence would begin with,
2 "Thereafter," and then would follow as printed, "this docket
3 should remain."

4 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Commissioners, an oral modification
5 from our staff on Issue 2, we close the docket item. Are there
6 any questions on the oral modification?

7 Seeing none, is there a motion to approve Item 8 as
8 modified?

9 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Move it.

10 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Second.

11 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Show Item 8 approved as modified.
