By Order No. PSC-06-0681-FOF-TL, issued August 7, 2006, in Docket No. 060300-TL, the Commission approved storm cost recovery of \$4,950 through a one-time charge of up to \$0.11 per access line to GT Com customers. On September 6, 2006, GTC, Inc. (GTC) appealed the Commission's Order to the Supreme Court of Florida. On September 6, 2007, the Florida Supreme Court affirmed Commission Order No. PSC-06-0681-FOF-TL.

The Commission Order directed that "this docket shall remain open for a period of time to allow us to verify the collected amount does not exceed the amount authorized." On October 31, 2007 staff contacted Mr. Robert Mark Elmer of GTC to determine if and when GTC would collect the surcharge from its customers. Mr. Elmer stated that GTC will not be imposing the one-time surcharge of \$0.11 on its customers. Therefore, no further action is necessary in this docket and the docket can be glosed.)
