COMES NOW Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC"), pursuant to section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(6), Florida Administrative Code, and submits this Revised Request for Protective Order and states as follows:

- 1. On November 8, 2007, FPUC filed its responses to the Citizens ("OPC") Second Request for Production of Documents and a Request for Protective Order and Temporary Order. Included in the Production of Documents Request was Request No. 28 which sought a copy of all documents used to analyze the salary levels of its employees undertaken in 2006 and 2007. FPUC objected to providing copies of this document as it is proprietary and confidential but the Company did offer to make the document available for review.
- 2. On November 15, 2007, the Company made a copy of the requested document available to OPC and would incorporate the reasons for the Protective Order herein and would add that the document includes an analysis of salary levels for employees of non-regulated and non-electric utilities as well as electric utility employees and for other businesses as well. To the extent the survey includes non-electric and non-company employees that information is proprietary and confidential and not subject to disclosure under Section 366.093, Florida Statutes.
