BACKGROUND

- 3. Indiantown Gas Company is a natural gas local distribution company ("LDC") providing natural gas transportation service in the State of Florida, and is a public utility subject to the Commission's regulatory jurisdiction under Chapter 366, Florida Statutes. Indiantown, Florida is an unincorporated rural community of approximately 5,000 residents in western Martin County. Indiantown Gas Company currently provides natural gas service to approximately 660 residential, 25 commercial and 3 industrial customers. In 2007, through its Order No. 07-0531-TRF-EG and Order No. 07-0593-CO-EG, the Commission approved the Company's Energy Conservation Program and ECCR tariffs. Before the approval of the Company's Plan in 2007, the Company did not have an Energy Conservation Program, and accordingly, there is no prior-period true-up amount for this proceeding.
- 4. The Company's calculation of the true-up amounts for which approval is hereby requested is consistent with the Commission's prescribed methodology for true-up calculations. The Company's calculations and supporting documentation are contained in Exhibit ____ (MMP-1) to the testimony of Melissa M. Powers, which consists of the Company's Energy Conservation Cost Recovery True-Up Reporting Forms. Both Ms.

Powers' testimony and Exhibit ____ (MMP-1) are being submitted for filing simultaneously with this Petition.

5. For the period January 1 through December 31, 2007, Indiantown Gas Company has calculated its end-of-period final true-up amount to be an over-recovery, including principal and interest, of \$1,633.

CONCLUSION AND RELIEF REQUESTED

6. As shown in Exhibit ____ (MMP-1), included for filing with this Petition, the Company's final end-of-period conservation cost recovery true-up amount for 2007 has been calculated in accordance with the Commission's prescribed methodology, and accordingly, the Company is entitled to the Commission's approval of that amount.

WHEREFORE, Indiantown Gas Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter its order approving the Company's end-of-period final energy conservation cost recovery true-up amount for the period January 1 through December 31, 2007.
