("VCI"), by and through its undersigned attorney, and hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.0022, Florida Administrative Code, this request for oral argument on its contemporaneously filed Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. PSC-08-0258-PCO-TX. VCI respectfully submits that oral argument on its Motion for Reconsideration would be beneficial in that the complexity of the request for reconsideration before the Commission is heightened by the fact that VCI was not provided an adequate opportunity to respond to the underlying Motion to Compel. 
