I am writing on behalf of Florida Power & Light Company to clarify a minor discrepancy in Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, dated April 11, 2008 in the above docket (the "Need Order").

On Page 13 under the heading "Transmission Costs," the Need Order identifies a range of \$664/kW to \$959/kW for transmission integration and interconnection costs. FPL's cost range provided in Exhibit SDS-6 was \$198 to \$242/kW for transmission integration and \$31/kW - \$37/kW for the costs of switchyard work (i.e., transmission interconnection), thus resulting in an overall range of \$229/kW to \$279/kW for transmission costs. FPL understands that the range of transmission costs referenced on page 13 of the Need Order includes owner's costs, whereas the range reflected in FPL's Exhibit SDS-6 does not. Owner's costs were included by FPL separately in the overall capital cost estimate range of \$3,108 to \$4,540/kW that appears in the previous section of the Need Order, entitled "Capital Cost Estimates."
