PROPOSED OCTOBER 2008 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the October 2008 data month. Results for the October 2008 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results	November 20, 2008
Final results	November 28, 2008

AT&T Florida provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the SQM Plan. This order specifies that when AT&T Florida proposes making any changes to the methods by which performance data is calculated, it must provide written notice. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. AT&T Florida must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

ENCORE Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (e.g., LEO, LESOG, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Florida will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as ENCORE Releases are implemented.

System releases related to the merger between BellSouth and AT&T may affect monthly data flows from the source systems that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Florida will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as system changes are implemented.

Ordering Measurements

(1) *Affected Measures:* O-9 (FOCT)

Description of Change: Currently, AT&T Florida has identified instances where LSRs are being classified as Partial Mechanized when these LSRs should be classified as Fully Mechanized. AT&T Florida proposes to modify the code in accordance with the business rules so that these LSRs are correctly classified as Fully Mechanized. (RQ9854)

Impact of Change:

For July 2008, the Florida metric for UNE 2W Analog Loop Partial Mechanized will change from 81.17% to 76.25%.

For July 2008, the Florida metric for UNE 2W Analog Loop Full Mechanized will have no impact to reported results.

Due to the impact of this change, AT&T Florida expects to re-post the July 2008 data month and is currently assessing other data months.
